**Gaumukh Tapovan trek** is a Himalayan challenge of 6 nights and 7 days. Witness the snout of the Gangotri Glacier at Gaumukh, the source of the Holy Ganga. Ascend rugged trails amidst breathtaking peaks like **Shivling** and **Bhagirathi**, Pushing your limits with every step. Find serenity in the meadows of Tapovan, a heaven for spiritual seekers and mountaineers. This 7-day adventure tests your resilience and rewards you with unforgettable landscapes, cultural immersion, and a deep connection to the Himalayas.



### - TREK HIGHLIGHTS-

- Witness the breathtaking beauty of the Gaumukh Glacier and Mount Shivling base camp.
- Immerse yourself in the tranquillity of Tapovan, a high-altitude meadow known for its beautiful views and peaceful atmosphere.
- Spot unique Himalayan Flora and Fauna, including rare birds, wildflowers, and even the majestic Himalayan Blue Sheep.
- Explore the picturesque town of Gangotri.
- Traverse through meadows, moraines, and rocky terrain, experience the distinct beauty of each ecosystem.
- Seek blessings at the sacred Ganga Temple, a pivotal pilgrimage site for hindus.
- Hike amidst majestic peaks like Bhagirathi, Shivling and Sudarshan, towering over you throughout the trek.



## - DETAILED ITINERARY -


# **DAY 01** DEHRADUN TO GANGOTRI (250 KMS/ 10 HOURS)

We will begin our journey at **6 AM** in the morning, Today will be longer, as you'll be travelling **250kms** to Gangotri. It will be an unforgettable 9-10 hours journey through the beautiful mountains. The famous hill station of **Mussoorie**, which is just 35kms from Dehradun, will be the first major attraction. From the hill station, you can see the **Shivalik Ranges**.

You'll arrive in **Uttarkashi**, which is situated on the Bhagirathi River's banks. All of the temples and holy people will convince you that you are really in the Land of the Gods. The Bhagirathi River leads to the picturesque **Harshil Town**.

We will reach Gangotri by evening and check in to our hotels.

Freshen-up, Relax, Have dinner and sleep overnight.



# **DAY 02** ACCLIMATIZATION DAY AT GANGOTRI (3100 M)

Day 2 is reserved as **acclimatization day** so that your body can get used to higher altitudes.

Start your day by witnessing the mesmerizing **Ganga Aarti** ceremony at the sacred Ganga Temple. Explore the intricate carvings and architecture of the temple, learning about its historical significance. Explore the nearby **Pandava Gufa**, a cave believed to have been used by the Pandavas during the exile.

You can also explore nearby locations like Surya Kund, Museum and Ganga Ghat.

# **DAY 03** GANGOTRI TO BHOJBASA (3800 M)

As you set forth on your trek from Gangotri, a checkpoint marks the beginning of your transformation. The landscapes change with each step, leading you into the heart of nature's wonders. The trek spans a manageable 5-6 hours, featuring a gradual ascent that lets you savour the journey.

From **Chirbasa to Bhojwasa**: Here the terrain undergoes a remarkable transformation, and you'll find yourself surrounded by a dense deodar tree jungle. Here, you'll encounter the narrow Pagdandi, a thrilling yet precarious passage with the Bhagirathi River on one side and towering mountains on the other.

Further along the trail, you'll arrive at Bhojwasa, named after the **Bhoj Patra** trees that flourish in the vicinity. In ancient times, these leaves were used to write epics such as the Ramayana and Mahabharata. Bhojwasa is more than a camping site; it's a gateway to breathtaking views of the Bhagirathi peaks.

After a nourishing lunch, take a leisurely break at the campsite, immersing yourself in the tranquillity of the surroundings. Night stay at Campsite.




# **DAY 04** BHOJBASA TO TAPOVAN (4500 M)

This is the toughest stretch of the trek, Pushing your limits both physically and mentally. Fuel up with a hearty breakfast and pack plenty of snacks and water. Get in queue to cross the Bhagirathi River via trolley. Tapovan is situated at **4,500m** and it takes 7-8 hours to reach.

The trail becomes steeper and rockier, requiring strong legs and good balance. Consider using a trekking pole for additional support on uneven terrain.

Once you reach **Tapovan**, the rocky path opens up to reveal stunning meadows and the imposing **Mt. Shivling**. This sacred place attracts spiritual seekers for meditation and serves as the base camp of Mt. Shivling expeditions.

Enjoy the breathtaking views of Mt. Shivling, **Mt. Meru**, and the **Bhagirathi Peaks**. After a challenging day, relax in your tent with the mountain goats as your companions.



### DAY 05 TAPOVAN TO BHOJBASA VIA GAUMUKH

After breakfast descend down towards **Gaumukh**. Remember going down can be trickier than climbing up —navigating around the scattered boulders requires focus and attention. Take your time, savor the journey, and enjoy the unique challenge. Today **5-6 hours** of trek will take you back to **Bhojbasa**.

Reach Gaumukh and soak in the sacred significance of this place. Witness firsthand the sources of the Ganges, a river vital to the lives and faith of millions in India and beyond. Allow yourself to be moved by its spiritual significance.

Reach Bhojbasa, where the familiar presence of towering pine trees welcomes you back. Nestled beside a flowing river, embraced by majestic mountains.



# DAY 06 BHOJBASA TO GANGOTRI

On the return journey from Bhojbasa to Gangotri, brace yourself for another scenic adventure.

Descending through the picturesque landscapes, you'll retrace your steps back to Gangotri. The trek covers approximately **15km** and takes **4-5 hours**, offering a different perspective of the stunning surroundings. Keep your camera ready, as you might encounter unique views and experiences on the way back.

As always, ensure you have enough water, snacks and enthusiasm for this part of the trek.

# **DAY 07** GANGOTRI TO DEHRADUN (250 KMS)

The journey from **Gangotri to Dehradun** marks the conclusion of our trekking expedition.

Descending from the heights of Gangotri, we'll drive back to Dehradun. The drive will cover approximately **250kms** and takes **8 hours**. As we bid farewell to the majestic landscapes, ensure you have your memories captured and cherish the experiences gained throughout the trek.

Travel safely, and feel free to soak in the last glimpses of the breathtaking scenery on this homeward stretch.

### -INCLUSIONS-

• Accomodation: Accomodation in Hotel/Guest house in Double/triple sharing.

Tent: Double/triple Sharing

- Transportation: from Dehradun to Gangotri and back to Dehradun.
- **Meals:** from Dinner on Day 1<sup>st</sup> to breakfast on Day 7<sup>th</sup>, all meals are included. We offer healthy, nutritious, and vegetarian food on all days of the trek.
- **Camping fee:** Both trekking permits and woodland camping fees are included in the price.
- Mules and Porters to carry central equipments.
- Experience guide, cook, helper, and porter.
- First aid kit with an oxygen cylinder and helmet.

#### **CANCELLATION BY OPERATOR**

#### Cancellation due to unforeseen circumstances before departure

If a trip is called off at the **last moment** due to any natural calamity/ unforeseen circumstances (Like Flood, Heavy rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc.) then the participants would be provided with a travel voucher for the same amount that can be used within a period of one year of the issuance date for any package worth the same amount. (Subject to availability)

#### Changes/Cancellation of the event after departure

If a trip has to be **aborted midway** due to any natural calamity (Like rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, bandh, etc.). In that case, the operator or the company is not liable to provide any refund or voucher if the group has departed from the pickup point.

#### **CANCELLATION BY CUSTOMER**

If the guest wishes to cancel any booking due to any reason, the same shall be only valid if operator is notified of the cancellation in writing on its official e-mail, at least 15days before the commencement of the trip or any adventure activity.

# **REFUND POLICY**

The following refund shall be payable to the guest in case of valid cancellation as per the guidelines.
